Ciarnad Ryan

"The Raven and the Writing Desk, an abstraction. The wolves dream of snow, the winter gardeners dream of Spring, the herbalist- the book, the soldier- the castle, the artist- the easel. Dreamtime? Invention? Riddles that have no answers."

Ciarnad Ryan lives in Borrisoleigh, Co Tipperary is an accomplished landscape designer, lecturer in horticulture and artist, specialising in painting and drawing. Ciarnad's work for this exhibition was developed while on residency at Damer House in the Summer of 2014 and was inspired by her research into medieval and Georgian events at Roscrea Castle and Damer House.

'Alice in Wonderland' Alice, for me, is how we see and understand the world our Elders conditioned us to live in and Alice's questioning, of finding her own world through her dogged belief in her intelligence, creativeness and girlish ingenuity, with panache and aplomb, shows the courage of her freedom of spirit to be herself. The title of this show 'The Raven and the Writing Desk' is a riddle that never should be answered, it is filled with such wonder, mystery and mischief that our imagination, life long, is always open to ponder. Patrick lives in Emo, Portlaoise and is a graduate of Limerick School of Art and Design where he graduated with a Masters in Fine Art (Printmaking). He has participated in numerous exhibitions and has won awards for his drawing skills.

Here are just some of the highlights for this year. You can also get more information on our website, www.terryglassartsfestival.ie Go on... have a go at something you have never tried before. Book early to avoid disappointment – **places are limited and sell out fast.**

Brick Flicks - Make your own stop motion movie! Collaborate on designing your own hand-made set, script your own story and film the results. Just bring your favorite Lego mini figure to star in your own adventure! This workshop is specifically designed and suitable for children 8yrs plus.

Watercolours with Rose Carty - A relaxed exploration of watercolour painting including materials, composition, colour work and trouble shooting. No experience necessary, just come along and enjoy yourself.

Tin Can Treasures - Decoupage - A creative way to upcycle tin cans for storage. Fun for everyone! Personalise your own tin can with this creative upcycling project whilst learning the technique of decoupage.



Finger Painting Fun - Toddler Time- Finger painting is a great natural sensory activity for kids and now you can also create a beautiful canvas masterpiece from this simple activity. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Lantern Making - Using willow, wire and tissue paper, spend 90 minutes with Nathalie El Baba making a lantern. This workshop can be a little tricky for little fingers, so children aged between 7 to 11 must be accompanied by an adult.

Dinky Doodles – Decorating that ROCKS! Handpaint beach pebbles to create your own pet monster, or fun character; design a decorative stone for the garden or as a fridge magnet with your name or a favourite quote.

Woodturning - With only 5 participants per workshops, expert woodturner Thomas Adlum is offering a fantastic opportunity for you to explore this ancient craft in a small group. This workshop proves extremely popular every year. Please **book early** to avoid disappointment.

Coppercraft These workshops are suitable for ages of 6 to 70 plus. Using recycled copper from old water tanks, participants can make a small copper leaf key ring or pendant.

Food For Mood - A cookery demonstration with a focus on adapting everyday recipes for optimum health and wellbeing, the emphasis being that what we eat can truly have a major effect on both our physical and mental health. The demonstration will feature fresh, local produce and includes a recipe booklet, sampling of the dishes prepared and a refreshing juice on arrival.

CHAROLAIS

'Charolais' takes the age old story of female jealousy and gives it a new twist: the other woman is a cow, a literal one, a purebred Charolais (French) heifer.

Noni Stapleton plays Siobhan, whose farmer boyfriend devotes considerable attention to his prize heifer at the expense of his very pregnant and disgruntled girlfriend. Siobhan has developed a homicidal jealousy for this Charolais and is feeling equally murderous towards her snobbish soon-to-be mother in law. A dark comedy of love and longing: rarely in theatre are the challenges of farming life and the joy of sex expressed so frankly or with such charm.

Charolais is written and performed by Noni Stapleton and directed by Bairbre Ni Chaoimh. Charolais was kindly supported by The Arts Council.

Charolais premiered in Dublin Fringe 2014 as part of Show in a Bag, an Artist development initiative of Dublin Fringe Festival, Fishamble: The New Play Company and Irish Theatre Institute to resource theatre makers and actors.
